The works of this exhibition draw on fundamental issues of our time; surveillance, liberty, resistance, personal journeys and accountability. The artists dream of a fairer future and question the beautiful and painful properties of impermanence. They try to make sense of our interconnectedness, looking for the real beneath the surface, trying to find justice and peace and the desire for transcendence.
