# June 1<sup>st</sup> – August 23<sup>rd</sup> 2020


On 28th April, the French Prime Minister announced the reopening of "small museums" as lockdown restrictions were eased across the country. The decision, which relaunched on-site cultural life, left many artists and cultural professionals in a state of doubt and confusion. Like many others, we were very pleased with the announcement, but we were also unsure about our ability to return to life as usual.

At La Kunsthalle Mulhouse, we believe in the absolute necessity to resume work with the artists and to show their works. Hence, our impromptu **Small Programme**.

The **Small Programme** brings together twelve artists we have welcomed before. They are regular partners of La Kunsthalle. This original project gives each of them free rein to choose a set of three works which will be on display for a week.

The Small Programme will be visible online, on social networks and on the art centre's website, for one week. At the same time, La Kunsthalle will become a place of reference where the works will be displayed progressively throughout the summer. The public will be able to go to the exhibition space for visits that are not quite ordinary, but absolutely safe.

Within the constraints of what we are allowed to do, and while continuing to reflect on the health crisis and its social repercussions, La Kunsthalle team hopes to make its own contribution to the debate on our future world.
